

The City of Englewood is centrally located within the Denver Metropolitan area. Just south of Denver, Englewood is ideally situated for citizens, business people, and visitors. Englewood offers a small town atmosphere of community with all the benefits of a larger metropolitan area nearby.

Government

Englewood is a home-rule City with a Council-Manager form of Government. The City was incorporated in 1903, and the City Charter was adopted by residents in 1958. The City Council is made up of seven members elected on a non-partisan basis. One representative is elected from each of the City's four districts, and three members are elected at large. Council Members serve four year terms. The Mayor and the Mayor Pro Tem are elected by the Council.

Climate

Colorado's climate is a principal asset to the high quality lifestyle residents enjoy. Moderate temperatures, combined with low levels of humidity provide comfortable weather.

About Englewood

Englewood is the 4th most populous city in Arapahoe County and, in 2000, was the 20th most populous city in Colorado.

The City of Englewood is a Home Rule Municipality located in Arapahoe County. As of 2007, its estimated total population is 32,532.

Englewood is part of the Denver-Aurora Metropolitan Area and is located in the South Platte River Valley east of the Front Range and immediately south of central Denver.

Downtown is located immediately east of the confluence of Little Dry Creek and the South Platte River, between Santa Fe Drive and

Broadway Street.
