

About Arapahoe County

Arapahoe County is the 3rd most populous county of Colorado. The United States Census Bureau estimates that the county population was 544,282 in 2008, a 10.09% increase since U.S. Census 2000.

The county seat is Littleton and the most populous city is Aurora.

Arapahoe County calls itself "Colorado's First County" since its origins predate the Pike's Peak Gold Rush.

In July 1858, gold was discovered along the South Platte River in Arapahoe County (in present day Englewood). This discovery precipitated the Pike's Peak Gold Rush.
