

About Jefferson County

Jefferson County is the fourth most populous of the 64 counties in Colorado. The US Census Bureau estimates that its population was 533,339 in 2008. The county seat is Golden and the most populous city is Lakewood. Jefferson County is part of the Denver-Aurora Metropolitan Statistical Area and the Denver-Aurora-Boulder Combined Statistical Area.

Interstate 70 traverses the county from east-to-west, passing south of the county seat of Golden. Jefferson County is nicknamed Jeffco, and is known as the Gateway to the Rocky Mountains.
